- **Mandatory Training Dates & Orientation Day (June 25, Aug 27, 28, 29)**
- **Attending Class once per cycle at lunch - CLASS comes first**
- **Link Training Follow Up (overnight, 2-day trip to MacSkimming Sept 19-20)**
- **Participation and leadership in Social Follow Ups (4 through year)**
- **Delivery of minimum two Academic Follow Ups**
- **Ongoing connection and support of your assigned group of grade nine students throughout the year.**
