- **Student Council Report (A. Nguyen and N. Rahman)**

1. School Operations

a. COVID-19 update

- i. [Daily Self-Assessment](#)
- ii. 2 student cases since September; both resolved; OPH investigation determined that they were not in school while contagious.
- iii. [OCDSB COVID-19 Dashboard](#)
 - CB is 6th largest school in the district – CB numbers are very low given size of school
 - Students are following recommendations very well and care staff are following thorough cleaning protocols

b. Operations

- i. Teachers on Leave (coverage) since September: R. Cooke (Justin Lee); B. Guindon (L. Juhnke); A. Lacasse (A. MacDonald).
- ii. Current enrollment: 1042 students in-person. Approximately 90 chose OCV.
 - high proportion of in-person learners (over 90%) – higher than seeing in most other secondary schools
- iii. Current section allocation: 371; 61.83 FTE. (last year = 415; 69.17 FTE)
- iv. IB Information Night
 1. Nov 18 @ 7:00pm by Zoom webinar
 2. [promotional video](#) – created to replace in-person school visits
- v. Commencement for Class of 2020:

- 2021 commencement currently booked for end of June – too early to say what we will be able to do
- Photo day – still waiting for information on how to proceed

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- Will there be any adjustments to IB program given student experience over the last few school years?
 - Much thought has been put into this – this year IBO has adjusted what is on May 2021 exams – but they look at this on exam period to exam period
 - Students continue to work on skills for IB during these years to prepare for the exams
- If student required to self-isolate, they can be working at home (if not ill) and can participate in synchronous learning, if they are ill then CB will work with student to provide alternative activities/assessments as necessary
