### → Students must earn the following compulsory credits:

3	credits in Mathematics (1 credit in grade 11 or 12)
2	credits in Science
1	credit in Canadian History
1	credit in Canadian Geography
1	credit in the Arts
1	credit in Health & Physical Education
1	credit in French as a Second Language
0.5	credit in Career Studies
0.5	credit in Civics

#### → Plus one credit from each of the following Groups:

These graduation requirements are in effect from March 2010 until revised by the Ministry of Education.

# **Colonel By Secondary School**

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A maximum of 3 credits in English as a Second Language (ESL) or English Literacy Development (ELD) may be counted towards the 4 compulsory credits in English, but the fourth must be a credit earned for a Grade 12 compulsory English course.

In Groups 1, 2, and 3, a maximum of two credits in French as a second language can count as compulsory credits, one from group 1 and one from either group 2 or group 3.

A maximum of 2 credits in Cooperative Education can count as compulsory credits.
